

Student Litter Cleanup Challenge

Terms and Conditions

1. ABOUT

The Canadian Parks and Wilderness Society (“CPAWS”) and its Manitoba Chapter (“CPAWS Manitoba”) are hosting the a Student Litter Cleanup Challenge (the “Contest”) in accordance with the Terms and Conditions contained herein, which all participants who enter the requested information (the “entry” or “entries”) into the Contest (the “participant” or “teacher” or “educator”) shall agree to and accept as binding upon them.

2. ELIGIBILITY

The Contest is open to teachers and educators and their classes in Manitoba. Only the teacher/educator who organizes the litter cleanup and completes the entry form shall be considered a participant with a valid entry. This can be done remotely or in-person. Please practise safe physical distancing and follow all [public health recommendations](#).

3. ENTRY PERIOD

The entry period for participants runs from May 1 at 12 a.m. CT until June 16, 2021 at 11:59 p.m. CT. All entries must be received within this period. CPAWS Manitoba is not responsible for entries that are lost, late, delayed, misdirected, unintelligible, illegible, incomplete, separated or undeliverable.

4. SUBMISSION CRITERIA

- 4.1. Teachers can organize more than one litter cleanup if they teach multiple classes. There is no limit to the number of times the teacher enters as long as it is with different classes. If any students participate remotely, they can send photos of the clean-up to their teacher, who will submit them through our entry form. **Each litter cleanup organized by the teacher must include a separate [Entry Form](#).**
- 4.2. After watching this [intro video](#), sharing the [lesson](#) with your students and completing this activity with your class, fill out this [Entry Form](#).
- 4.3. To prove participation, the entry forms asks the teacher to submit photos of the activity. If there are identifiable people and you give us permission to use the photo for promotional purposes, please submit a Model Release Form signed by each person and their parent/guardian. - 4.4. All photos proving participation must be of legal activities, taking into consideration safety and any local, municipal, provincial or federal law governing parks or protected areas where the photos are taken. All photos must show respect for the subject and the environment. On suspicion of disturbance or damaging nature, the teacher and their class will be excluded from entry into the Contest.

4.5. For a bonus entry, post about the great work your students did on social media with the hashtag #CPAWSLitterCleanup, and tag or mention CPAWS Manitoba in your post. You can find us on [Facebook](#), [Twitter](#) and [Instagram](#).

5. PRIZES

Regardless of whether a participant wins the Contest, all entries will be subject to section 6.1 of these Terms and Conditions.

5.1. All eligible entries will be entered into random draws to win one of three prizes, with winners notified by June 17, 2021. The winner must select a doughnut party date by end of day June 21, 2021. Participants can win up to one prize each. Non-winning entries shall not be notified. The winners shall be posted on the CPAWS Manitoba website by June 18, 2021.

5.2. All decisions of the contest organizers are final.

5.3. Prizes: Three prizes will be awarded. The winners will be randomly selected. Each winner will receive a class doughnut party at the end of June from Oh Doughnuts or treats from their local bakery.

5.4. Prior to receiving a prize, the winners will be required to sign an agreement ([Entry Form](#)) declaring that they agree to the rules and regulations.

6. PERMISSIONS AND RELEASE

6.1. By entering the contest you agree to let CPAWS and CPAWS Manitoba post photos you submitted of your litter cleanup on our social media networks, blog and other publications and presentations, be they print or electronic or other media and/or otherwise publicly display all photos submitted. The teacher gives their consent to the organizer, for an indefinite period, unless otherwise advised, to display their name along with the submitted photos.

6.2. If the teacher submits photos solely to prove their participation and not for promotion purposes, they may opt out by ticking the box on the entry form.

6.3. By submitting the entry, the participant consents and agrees to these Terms and Conditions.
